Dear Student and Parents,

During challenging times, a key personality trait that allows us to remain successful is 'resilience'. Resilience is actually one of our 8 *Personal Goals*. *Personal Goals* are an integral part of the ISZ experience and are intended to help students develop character traits that allow them to be successful in life. Opportunities to experience and practice these are built into the learning tasks within each unit of work.
