

*Welcome all ISZ Boarders!*

*Our boarding school is something very special as we do not live on campus, but are part of an exciting new development community called Fumba Town Community.*

*Fumba is located in the southeastern tip of the island. A new town that has been designed from scratch to the highest international standards has been under development for a few years now. The feel of Fumba Town is like a small seaside community.*

*Let's describe a typical day so that you have a good idea what boarding at ISZ is like.*

*6:45am: The alarm goes off in a modern 2 bedroom apartment. Tired boarding students make their way into the bathroom while another student prepares a morning cup of tea in the kitchen.*

*7:00am: Students make their way to the kwetu kwenu kiosk where a delicious and nutritious breakfast awaits them. The ingredients we use here are ecologically farmed. The kiosk is a meeting place for the community and greetings are exchanged with fellow boarders as well as with local community people on their way to work. Everyone knows everyone else. A real community. Now quick back to the room to grab the school bag.*

*7:20am The school bus leaves for ISZ. Fumba town is secured 24/7, and access to the area is strictly controlled. Everyone who enters or leaves is registered at the gate. The drive takes us past the local village and the airport. After 20 minutes you arrive at ISZ.*

*7:45am: Homeroom at ISZ starts. By the way, you receive a delicious snack and a healthy lunch from kwetu kwenu. Don't forget to pick it up!*

*3pm: The school day is officially ending. Those students who are engaged in one of the many after school activities are staying on until 4pm.*

*3:30pm or 4:30pm: Time for a break and a snack at the kiosk back in Fumba Town. It is also a moment to relax with other boarders, to have some free time, to play or to meet with local children. A breeze comes off the ocean which is just a few meters away. Trees offer shade, and the local gardens invite you to play and explore. Children are free to safely roam the entire development area. Cars must drive at slow speeds. Everything is neat and clean and well maintained. There is even a clinic with a qualified doctor from Germany who can take care of all outpatient (and some inpatient) needs. There are some small shops and a restaurant overlooking the ocean. Sports activities are also on offer. It is time to do your homework now and prepare for tomorrow's lessons. You will return to a clean apartment. Each apartment has 2 bedrooms, a kitchen, bathroom, common room, and of course a high speed internet connection. Enough room for everyone to be him- or herself and have some alone time.*

*7pm: Dinner time. Off to kwetu kwenu with your fellow boarders. You can watch the sunset and then enjoy a delicious dinner under the stars. On the weekends, there are events like movie nights or a farmers market.*

*8:30pm: It is time to retire back to the apartment to have some final moments with friends or studying. It is soon time for bed in the complete safety of Fumba Town.*
